Dear Parent/Guardian:

It has been brought to our attention that cars parked on Broad Street in front of Central School during drop off and pick up are being ticketed. As per communication in September, parking is prohibited. The district works collaboratively with the Keyport Police Department to ensure that children remain safe. Broad Street is a busy street and when cars are parked on the street, this creates a safety hazard.

In order to assist with drop off, the Safety Patrol who are monitored by staff, will be stationed by the entrance of the building. This will allow for parents dropping off our Pre K-Grade 1 students to be escorted to the building. Please keep in mind that as long as students are quickly brought to the front entrance walkway, the process will be streamlined and concerns of ticketing will diminish. Therefore limiting the time cars are stationary on Broad Street. KPD understands the impact of inclement weather on this process.

Again, please understand that the safety of your children is the top priority for KPD and the district. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact my office.
