To that end, all students should be taking advantage of our Targeted Instruction program during Open Lunch. At some point during the Open Lunch period, each teacher is available for extra help. This provides our students with the opportunity to seek and receive extra help during the day as opposed to staying after school as in previous school years.

In addition, the open period on Wednesdays is set aside for clubs and activities. Students are encouraged to join any club they like and take advantage of the chance to participate in these activities during school hours.
